1) Collect food scraps in a "kitchen caddy" lined with a compostable bag, if available.

3) Drop off food scraps at OCRRA's Jamesville or Amboy Compost Site.

NOTE: Caddies, bags and transportation containers are <u>not</u> required, but make the process easier and less messy.

Food Scrap Collection Tips

Kitchen Caddy Ideas:

- Reuse a coffee container.
- Any plastic container with a lid (about 2.5 gallon size).

Transportation Container Ideas:

- 5-gallon pail.
- Kitty litter container.

Odor Control Tips

- Sprinkle baking soda on top of food scraps.
- Keep transportation container in the garage or outdoors in the shade.
- Freeze meat, dairy and cooking liquids until your next trip to the Compost Site.

Site Services

OCRRA operates two compost sites (Amboy and Jamesville). Site passes may be used at either or both sites.

Passes

Residents may purchase one of three different passes for use at both locations.

Based on pass type, users may drop off food and yard waste (organics) or pick up mulch and / or compost.

All users must unload their own materials. Yard waste and food waste must be dropped off in the appropriate collection area.

Pass Pricing

Basic Pass: \$20

Entitles you to **drop off** food and yard waste only. No pick up.

- Plus Pass: \$35
 Entitles you to drop off of food and yard waste and self-load pick up of 6 cy of mulch <u>or</u> 3 cy of compost.
- Premium Pass: \$50
 Entitles you to drop off of food and yard waste and OCRRA loading of 6 cy of mulch <u>or</u> 3 cy of compost.

If more material is needed, another pass may be purchased or material may be purchased by the bag or on a per yard basis.

Note: If pass is lost there will be a \$10 charge for a replacement. Only <u>one</u> replacement pass / customer.

Prohibited Items

NO: Plastic, Styrofoam, glass, metal, pet waste, diapers, garbage, concrete, asphalt, rocks, metal, **plastic** (including bags), rubber, lumber, stumps and oversized tree trunks (greater than 24 inches in diameter or more than 12 feet long).

Acceptable Items

• Food Waste

Meats, fish, fruits, veggies, grains,



eggs, dairy, paper napkins and cups, paper towels, coffee filters and tea bags.

Soft Yard Waste

Garden wastes, weeds, grass clippings, straw, hay, leaves and plants.



• Hard Yard Waste

Brush, hedge trimmings, sticks pine cones, pine needles, vines, tree limbs and trunks (less than 24 inches in diameter and 12 feet long).
