

Kevin Spillane is the Director of Transfer Operations for the Onondaga County Resource Recovery Agency (OCRRA). He has 30 years of public management experience in both the public and not-for-profit sectors, 15 years of which were in solid waste.

Spillane developed and operated county-wide recycling programs in Seneca and Ontario Counties including the: operation of a 500 ton per day material recovery facility; oversight of a 1,200 ton per day landfill that involved site expansions and more than \$13 million dollars in upgrades; operation of transfer stations that ranged from small towns to a large consolidated facility.

He also developed and oversaw the business operations of a not-for-profit that provided employment to individuals with intellectual disabilities for more than a decade.
