

2019 Newsletter RFP Questions & Answers

Q1: What is the specification for the paper? It notes 40% recycled, but not what type of paper (i.e. 30# Newsprint, 40# 80 Bright News, 50# Offset).

A1: We are looking for standard newsprint, something in the range of 28# –30#.

Q2: Is the 40% recycled required or a goal? What if we have 0% recycled?

A2: 40% or more is desired, however, OCRRA will accept bids for less than 40% recycled content stock. Proposal evaluations will be scored accordingly.

Q3: Reading your proposal it says sheet size 23"x17", and folds in half, twice, to a final size of 8.5x11. Then a couple paragraphs down it list Number of sheets: 2. Does this mean that there are 2 sheets of 23x17 and do they need to be nested within each other to form your newsletter?

A3: Yes, there are two 23 x 17" sheets nested inside one another. This nested set of sheets is then folded in half two times (first along the 17" dimension and then along the 11" dimension), resulting in an 11 x 8-1/2" final piece.

Q4: Can we submit a bid for just the printing, since we do not offer graphic design services?

A3: Yes.
