There are many ways to manage batteries in Onondaga County. If you have alkalines, rechargeables or button batteries visit one of OCRRA's free drop boxes at partnering locations. They must be separated by type for drop off. Check labels to determine what kinds of batteries you have.



**Alkaline, rechargeable and button batteries**

To properly dispose of fluorescent bulbs from your home, residents may bring them to:

- **Any of the hardware stores listed on back where they will be recycled.** OCRRA makes this free service available to all households in Onondaga County. *Only CFLs, 2-foot, 4-foot, U-shaped and circular bulbs are accepted.*



- **Participating Home Depot or Lowe's stores.** *Only CFLs—the small “twirly” kind—are accepted.*
- **OCRRA's free Household Toxics Drop-off program.** All bulbs (including 8-foot) accepted. Must bring in other acceptable household toxics along with bulbs. Appointment required. Visit [www.tinyurl.com/OCRRAtoxics](http://www.tinyurl.com/OCRRAtoxics) for details.
