

Kevin Spillane is the Executive Director of the Onondaga County Resource Recovery Agency (OCRRA). He came to the role in January 2022 after serving OCRRA for nearly six years as the Director of Transfer Operations.

Spillane brings 30+ years of public management experience to the job from both the public and not-for-profit sectors, including 15 years in solid waste. He developed and operated recycling programs in Seneca and Ontario Counties, which involved the oversight of a 500 ton per day material recovery facility, a 1,200 ton per day landfill, site expansions and multi-million dollar upgrades.

For more than a decade, Spillane developed and oversaw the business operations of a not-for-profit that provided employment to individuals with intellectual disabilities.

Spillane holds a Master of Public Administration degree from Syracuse University's Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs. He is a lifelong resident of Central New York and the Finger Lakes Region.
