CURBSIDE RECYCLING

PAPER



- Boxes (empty/flatten)
- Newspaper & magazines
- Mail & office papers
- Paper bags (empty/flatten)
- Softcover books

PLASTIC



- Ignore numbers; recycle by container shape
- Bottles, jugs, jars & stackable dairy tubs only
- Empty, rinse & reattach lids*

METAL



- Food & drink cans
- Aluminum disposable pans bowls plates & foil (please clean & wad up)

GLASS



- Food containers
- Beverage bottles, including wine & spirits (any color)
- Empty, rinse & reattach lids*



TRASH



- Fridge & freezer boxes
- Takeout boxes
- Egg cartons (any kind)
- Disposable plates & bowls
- Napkins & tissues



- Hoses, string lights & cords
- Takeout boxes & clamshells (for berries, salad, etc.)
- Disposable utensils
- Pool covers & liners



- Small appliances
- Chains, cables, leashes, etc.
- Empty paint cans
- Mixed metal/cardboard canisters (coffee, oatmeal)



- Dishes glasses & mugs
- Ovenware & ceramics
- Window & picture glass
- Mirrors
- Broken glass
