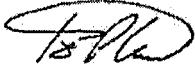

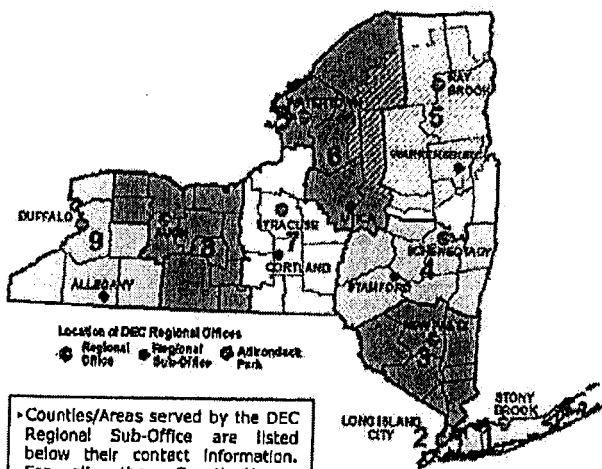

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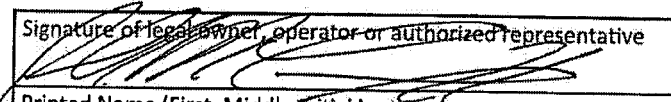

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. **Conformance With Plans** All activities authorized by this permit must be in strict conformance with the permit application, plans and materials prepared by the applicant, received on July 31, 2006; May 21, 2007; June 26, 2007; August 13, 2007; August 2017.
2. **Authorized Materials** This permit is issued for the operation of a storage and transfer facility which is authorized to accept and manage the following:
 - used oil,
 - non-hazardous commercial/industrial waste,
 - household hazardous waste,
 - hazardous waste from conditionally exempt small quantity generators,
 - gasoline/fuel product mixtures, and,
 - asbestos waste.
3. **Conformance with Regs, Application and Any Modifications, and Handbook** All aspects of the operation shall be performed in strict accordance with all applicable sections of 6NYCRR Part 360 Solid Waste Management Waste Facilities Regulations, the permit application, all approved permit modification application requests and the August 2017(revised) Facility Management Handbook.
4. **Timing for Facility Operation** This facility is permitted to operate 24 hours a day, 7 days/week, 365 days per year with normal business hours being Monday thru Friday 7a.m. to 5p.m. Operation of this facility outside the normal business hours shall be allowed to perform emergency environmental services.
5. **Certificate of Compliance** A current Certificate of Compliance issued by the Syracuse Fire Department must be submitted to the DEC Region 7, Division of Materials Management, Syracuse Office. (For Department address see Solid Waste Management Permit (SWMP) Condition No. 49.)
6. **Access To and Use of Facility** Access to and use of the facility must be strictly and continuously controlled by fencing, gates, signs and other suitable means.
7. **Surveillance System** The facility must be equipped with a 24 hour surveillance system (television monitoring or guards or security personnel) which continuously monitors and controls entry onto the active portion of the facility; or an artificial or natural barrier (a properly installed fence with a minimum of 7 feet in height) which completely surrounds the active portion of the facility, and a means to control entry to the active portion of the facility through gates or other entrances.



8. Posting of Facility Sufficient signs must be posted at each entrance to the active portion of the facility and at other locations to be seen from any approach to the active portion. The signs must be legible from at least 25 feet and must contain the statement "Danger-Unauthorized Personnel Keep Out".

9. Site Inspections Environmental Products & Services of Vermont, Inc. shall allow any representative of the NYSDEC, referred to as the "Department", in this permit, and/or the Onondaga County Health Department, upon presentation of proper credentials to:

- Have access to and copy, at reasonable times, any records that must be kept under the conditions of this permit, including any and all confidential data included in such report;
- Enter and inspect at reasonable times, the facilities equipment (including monitoring and control equipment), practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
- Sample or monitor, at reasonable times, for the purpose of assuring permit compliance or as otherwise authorized by the ECL, any substances or parameters at the facility.

10. Designate Person in Charge The permittee must designate at least one person stationed at the facility to be in charge. No operations may be conducted unless one of these persons or their designees is present at the facility.

11. Transportation of Regulated Waste

- All waste transported to the facility must be by transporters who are permitted, as required by 6NYCRR Part 364 regulations, unless otherwise exempt from the 6NYCRR Part 364 permitting requirement.
- All transportation of regulated waste from the storage facility must be performed by a 6NYCRR Part 364 permitted waste transporter.

12. Spill Prevention Control & Countermeasures (SPCC) Plan A copy of the Spill Prevention Control & Countermeasures (SPCC) Plan, dated August 2017 (revised), must be kept available at the facility work area. The SPCC Plan must be reviewed annually and updated when changes occur. A copy of the revised SPCC Plan must be sent to the DEC Region 7, Division Materials Management (DMM), Syracuse Office and all SPCC Plan holders. (For Department address see SWMP Condition No. 49.)

13. SPCC Plan and Emergency Services A copy of the most recent revised SPCC Plan must be sent to the local fire department, police department, and anyone that may be called upon to provide emergency services. The permittee must ensure these departments are familiar with the facility and its operations.

14. SPCC Plan Emergency Call List Posted The emergency call list in the SPCC Plan must be posted in the work area, near a phone. This list must be kept current.

15. SPCC Emergency Equipment Adequate types and amounts of emergency equipment, as indicated in the SPCC Plan, shall be maintained onsite and in good condition at all times.

16. SPCC Plan Implementation The SPCC Plan must be implemented when necessary.

17. Waste Must be Characterized All wastes that are accepted at this facility must be characterized, using chemical analysis or other approved method, as described in the August 2017 Quality Control and Audit Information and 6NYCRR Part 374-2 Regulations. The receipt of all waste must be recorded.



18. Halogen Testing Used oil in all incoming containers, including but not limited to, tank trucks, tanker cars, and drums, must be tested, regardless of the container's labeling, upon arrival at the facility for total halogen content in accordance with the facility's Analysis Plan, as required by 374-2.6(f), in accordance with 374-2.5(e)(2) and 374-2.6(d). In accordance with Part 374-2.6(d)(1)(i), if all analysis is not conducted at an ELAP certified laboratory, then 5% of the samples obtained must be split-sampled, and one of the splits shall be provided to an ELAP certified laboratory and analyzed for confirmation of total halogen content utilizing an analytical method (i.e., not a field screening method) from EPA Publication SW-846, Edition III. All sampling methodology, containers and preservatives specific to the method used must be followed.

Any used oil having equal to or greater than 1,000 ppm by weight in total halogen content is presumed by the Department to be a hazardous waste due to mixing of the used oil with a listed hazardous waste. Unless that presumption can be rebutted (for example, by demonstrating that no such mixing occurred, or by demonstrating that mixing was solely performed by a CESQG), the facility must reject the oil that failed and notify the Department's appropriate Regional Engineer within two hours by phone or email, and three days by letter, in accordance with 374-2.6(f)(3)(iii).

Please be aware that the hazardous waste generator status of client facilities may change at any time. Reliance upon a client facility's historical status as a CESQG will put the permittee at risk of enforcement should a client no longer have CESQG status and the permittee accepts used oil from them that is contaminated with hazardous waste.

19. RCRA Non-Hazardous Used Oil and Used Oil/Water Mixtures On-site tank storage of RCRA non-hazardous used oil and used oil-water mixtures shall not exceed 14,000 U.S. gallons in Area B and not more than 5,000 gallons in Area K. In addition, a maximum of two hundred (200) 55 gallon drums, of oil and oil/water mixtures, may be stored in Area B.

20. Tanks for Waste Oil and PBS Regs All tanks used for the storage of waste oil must be in compliance with Petroleum Bulk Storage Regulations.

21. Gasoline/Gasoline-Water Mixture A maximum of 7,000 gallons of gasoline/gasoline-water mixture may be stored in a tank in Area K.

22. Gasoline/Water Separator Process Unit No gasoline/water mixture or any other fluid mixture containing gasoline shall be processed at this facility until the gasoline/water separator process unit has been constructed to the specifications outlined in the 1994 application and has been certified as constructed in accordance with the specifications by a NYS Licensed Engineer.

23. Gasoline/Water Processing Must Obtain Proper Permits No gasoline/water mixture or any other fluid mixtures containing gasoline (except those currently allowed gasoline/water mixture streams received from Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG's) customers) shall be processed at this facility until the appropriate air permits and water discharge permit are obtained from the Department and Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection, respectively.

24. No Disposal of Gasoline On-Site No gasoline, or water containing gasoline shall be disposed of on-site.

25. 6NYCRR Part 364 Transporters Required for Gasoline/Mixtures Only NYSDEC permitted 6NYCRR Part 364 waste transporters shall transport gasoline/water mixtures to the facility.



26. Acceptance of Gasoline/Water Mixtures No loads of gasoline/water mixtures shall be accepted when the gasoline storage tank is full.

27. Sampling of Sediments from Gasoline/Water Separator Sediments generated from the gasoline/water separator must be analyzed for Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure (TCLP) Benzene, TCLP Lead and Flashpoint, prior to shipping off site. If the samples exceed the hazardous waste criteria as defined in 6NYCRR Part 371 "Identification and Listing of Hazardous Wastes" (dated September 5, 2006), the waste must be handled and disposed of as hazardous waste.

28. Tank Storage of Gasoline/Water Mixtures

- The 10,000 gallon tank will be constructed of steel and have secondary containment of at least 110%.
- Tank storage of gasoline/water mixtures is allowed only after one 10,000 gallon storage tank is installed and registered with the Department.
- The 10,000 gallon tank will be incorporated into the gasoline/water treatment system once the system is constructed.

29. Bill of Lading/Manifesting of Gasoline/Water Mixture Shipments A bill of lading must be provided for gasoline/water mixture shipments that are received at this facility and are destined for recycling. Any shipments of gasoline/water mixtures that are not destined for recycling and meet the definition of hazardous waste must be manifested.

30. Particulate Air-Cleaning, Control Equipment for Asbestos

- Particulate control equipment is required to be operating during all asbestos transfer operations, at the facility; said control equipment shall never discharge visible emissions to the outside air, during transfer operations.
- Permittee must operate and maintain air-cleaning, control equipment in accordance with manufacturers' specifications and recommendations. An updated Control Equipment Inspection, Monitoring and Maintenance Plan shall be identified, drafted and submitted to the Department, for approval within 60 days of issuance of this permit. Any changes to the plan shall be submitted to the Department for approval prior to implementing changes. (For Department address see SWMP Condition No. 49.)
- A log shall also be kept of any equipment breakdowns, upsets, repairs, maintenance, or other deviations from expected design parameters; any control equipment breakdowns (which require immediate shut-down, and correction (repair), prior to restart); or significant asbestos release (including any visible emissions) due to broken plastic storage bags, or otherwise, shall be reported to this office within twenty-four (24) hours of the occurrence.

31. Record Keeping for Asbestos Records, including waste shipment documents which reference: name, address, telephone number of waste generator, quantity of asbestos-containing material in cubic meters (or cubic yards), name and telephone number of waste disposal site operator, name and physical site location of the disposal site, date transported, name, address, and telephone number of the transporter(s), and a certification that the contents of this consignment are fully and accurately described by proper shipping name, and are classified, packed, marked and labeled, and are in all respects in proper condition for transport by highway according to applicable international and government regulations, shall be maintained on-site for a period of two (2) years for DEC verification and review.

32. Sign on Vehicles/Trailers Concerning Asbestos Hazard Mark the vehicles and storage trailers,



used to transport, load and/or unload asbestos-containing waste material, so that the signs are visible and are displayed in such a manner and location that a person can easily read the legend.

33. **Compliance with Other Agencies for Asbestos Concerns** Permittee shall comply with all other state and federal (EPA, OSHA, MSHA, DOT) regulations which govern the handling, or storage of asbestos, as they may apply, to this facility.
34. **New Scientific Information, Pertaining to Asbestos, May Require Permit Modification by Department** Should significant new scientific evidence from a recognized institution result in a decision by the Department that lower ambient guideline concentrations must be established, it may be necessary to reduce asbestos emissions from this source prior to the expiration of this Permit.
35. **Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)** Wastes that are collected at an approved Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) cleanup event sponsored or co-sponsored by a community or governmental organization on a not-for-profit basis may be accepted at the facility. HHW may also be accepted from households and waste from Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG's). Hazardous Waste, other than waste from a CESQG may not be accepted.
36. **Incompatible, Ignitable, and Reactive Wastes** Incompatible, ignitable, and reactive wastes can not be mixed or handled in a manner that could result in an explosion or other reaction.
37. **Record Storage Locations** The storage location of each waste type must be recorded. Any relocation during storage and release for disposal must be documented.
38. **Storage and Handling of Waste** Each waste must be handled and stored in an appropriate manner for its characteristics and hazards.
39. **Barriers Between Stored Wastes** Barriers must be provided between stored wastes and any incompatible materials.
40. **Containers/Drums**
- Containers must be made of or lined with materials that will not react with, and are compatible with, the waste to be stored, so the ability to contain the waste will not be impaired.
 - Containers, when holding waste, must always be closed except when adding or removing waste. They may not be opened, handled or stored in a manner which may cause them to be ruptured and cause a leak.
 - Containers must be protected from excessive heat or cold and large temperature fluctuations. Containers which contain "Household Hazardous Waste" must be labeled as such.
 - Individual waste log sheets must be kept for each drum; they shall include the chemical constituents, amount and start and finish date. They shall be attached to each drum in use, and kept on file at the facility when the drums are removed or disposed.
 - Each container must be identified as to the hazard class of the contents.
41. **HHW Storage Time** HHW may be accumulated onsite for a maximum period of ninety (90) days. The time begins whenever the quantity of accumulated HHW exceeds 1000 kilograms.



42. Waste Must be Packaged, Labeled and Manifested All wastes must be packaged, labeled and manifested in accordance with 6NYCRR Parts 372.2 and 372.3. If all wastes originate in households, it is not necessary to use NYS Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest. Shipping papers or USEPA Hazardous Waste Manifest may be used instead to transport the waste from the collection site to the Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (TSDF). The forms must be approved by the Department.

43. HHW Disposed at Hazardous Waste TSDF All HHW must be sent to and disposed of at a hazardous waste TSDF that has been permitted pursuant to 6NYCRR Part 373 or, an otherwise, appropriately permitted facility.

44. Develop and Implement a Written Schedule for Inspection of Equipment To prevent, detect and respond to environmental or human health hazards, Permittee shall develop and implement a written schedule for inspecting:

- Monitoring equipment,
- Safety equipment,
- Emergency equipment,
- Security devices, and
- Operating and structural equipment.

45. Weekly Inspections The facility must be inspected weekly for all malfunctions and deteriorations, operator errors and discharges which may cause a release of waste constituents to the environment or result in a threat to human health. Any deterioration or malfunctions found during the weekly inspections must be corrected and documented in the inspection log.

46. Record Weekly Inspections The weekly inspections must be recorded in an inspection log or summary and must be kept at the facility for at least 7 years. These records must include at least the date and time of the inspection, the inspectors name, a notation of observations that were made, and the date and nature of any repairs or remedial action.

47. Notify Department of Facility Changes Environmental Products and Services of Vermont, Inc. shall notify the Department, in writing, of any planned physical alterations or additions to the facility that affect permit compliance before they are implemented.

48. Update the Facility Management Handbook By March 1 of each year, the Permittee shall provide updates to the Facility Management Handbook ("Handbook"). The facility shall be operated in accordance with this modified Handbook once the updates are deemed acceptable, in writing, by the Department.

49. Annual Report By March 1 of each year, the Permittee shall submit an Annual Report to the Department in accordance with 6NYCRR Part 360-14.3(d). Copies of the Report shall be sent to:

50. Financial Assurance Financial Assurance in the amount of \$110,190 must be submitted to the Department prior to the facility beginning operations. Every three years from the date of this permit, the Permittee shall update the financial surety estimate for closing the facility. The updated shall account for such changes as inflation, available markets, and increased disposal cost. Within 30 days of receiving written notice that the estimate is acceptable, the Permittee shall update the financial surety instrument to an amount sufficient to cover all anticipated closure and post closure cost, as determined by the Department.

GENERAL CONDITIONS - Apply to ALL Authorized Permits:
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1. Facility Inspection by The Department The permitted site or facility, including relevant records, is subject to inspection at reasonable hours and intervals by an authorized representative of the Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) to determine whether the permittee is complying with this permit and the ECL. Such representative may order the work suspended pursuant to ECL 71- 0301 and SAPA 401(3).

The permittee shall provide a person to accompany the Department's representative during an inspection to the permit area when requested by the Department.

A copy of this permit, including all referenced maps, drawings and special conditions, must be available for inspection by the Department at all times at the project site or facility. Failure to produce a copy of the permit upon request by a Department representative is a violation of this permit.

2. Relationship of this Permit to Other Department Orders and Determinations Unless expressly provided for by the Department, issuance of this permit does not modify, supersede or rescind any order or determination previously issued by the Department or any of the terms, conditions or requirements contained in such order or determination.

3. Applications For Permit Renewals, Modifications or Transfers The permittee must submit a separate written application to the Department for permit renewal, modification or transfer of this permit. Such application must include any forms or supplemental information the Department requires. Any renewal, modification or transfer granted by the Department must be in writing. Submission of applications for permit renewal, modification or transfer are to be submitted to:

4. Submission of Renewal Application The permittee must submit a renewal application at least 180 days before permit expiration for the following permit authorizations: Solid Waste Management.

5. Permit Modifications, Suspensions and Revocations by the Department The Department reserves the right to exercise all available authority to modify, suspend or revoke this permit. The grounds for modification, suspension or revocation include:



- a. materially false or inaccurate statements in the permit application or supporting papers;
- b. failure by the permittee to comply with any terms or conditions of the permit;
- c. exceeding the scope of the project as described in the permit application;
- d. newly discovered material information or a material change in environmental conditions, relevant technology or applicable law or regulations since the issuance of the existing permit;
- e. noncompliance with previously issued permit conditions, orders of the commissioner, any provisions of the Environmental Conservation Law or regulations of the Department related to the permitted activity.

6. Permit Transfer Permits are transferrable unless specifically prohibited by statute, regulation or another permit condition. Applications for permit transfer should be submitted prior to actual transfer of ownership.

NOTIFICATION OF OTHER PERMITTEE OBLIGATIONS

Item A: Permittee Accepts Legal Responsibility and Agrees to Indemnification

The permittee, excepting state or federal agencies, expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Department of Environmental Conservation of the State of New York, its representatives, employees, and agents ("DEC") for all claims, suits, actions, and damages, to the extent attributable to the permittee's acts or omissions in connection with the permittee's undertaking of activities in connection with, or operation and maintenance of, the facility or facilities authorized by the permit whether in compliance or not in compliance with the terms and conditions of the permit. This indemnification does not extend to any claims, suits, actions, or damages to the extent attributable to DEC's own negligent or intentional acts or omissions, or to any claims, suits, or actions naming the DEC and arising under Article 78 of the New York Civil Practice Laws and Rules or any citizen suit or civil rights provision under federal or state laws.

Item B: Permittee's Contractors to Comply with Permit

The permittee is responsible for informing its independent contractors, employees, agents and assigns of their responsibility to comply with this permit, including all special conditions while acting as the permittee's agent with respect to the permitted activities, and such persons shall be subject to the same sanctions for violations of the Environmental Conservation Law as those prescribed for the permittee.

Item C: Permittee Responsible for Obtaining Other Required Permits

The permittee is responsible for obtaining any other permits, approvals, lands, easements and rights-of-way that may be required to carry out the activities that are authorized by this permit.

Item D: No Right to Trespass or Interfere with Riparian Rights

This permit does not convey to the permittee any right to trespass upon the lands or interfere with the riparian rights of others in order to perform the permitted work nor does it authorize the impairment of any rights, title, or interest in real or personal property held or vested in a person not a party to the

WASTE TRANSPORTER PERMIT

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The permittee must:

1. Carry a copy of this waste transporter permit in each vehicle to transport waste. Failure to produce a copy of the permit upon request is a violation of the permit.
2. Display the full name of the transporter on both sides of each vehicle and display the waste transporter permit number on both sides and rear of each vehicle containing waste. The displayed name and permit number must be in characters at least three inches high and of a color that contrasts sharply with the background.
3. Transport waste only in authorized vehicles. An authorized vehicle is one that is listed on this permit.
4. Submit to the Department a modification application for additions/deletions to the authorized fleet of vehicles. The permittee must wait for a modified permit before operating the vehicles identified in the modification application.
5. Submit to the Department a modification application to add a new waste category or a new destination facility, or to change the current waste or destination facility category. The permittee must wait for a modified permit before transporting new waste types or transporting to new destination facilities.
6. Submit to the Department a modification application for change of address or company name.
7. Comply with requirements for placarding and packaging as set forth in New York State Transportation Law as well as any applicable federal rules and regulations.
8. Contain all wastes in the vehicle so there is no leaking, blowing, or other discharge of waste.
9. Use vehicles to transport only materials not intended for human or animal consumption unless the vehicle is properly cleaned.
10. Comply with requirements for manifesting hazardous waste, regulated medical waste, or low-level radioactive waste as set forth in the New York State Environmental Conservation Law and the implementing regulations. Transporters who provide a pre-printed manifest to a generator/shipper/offeror of regulated waste shall ensure that all information is correct and clearly legible on all copies of the manifest.
11. Deliver waste only to transfer, storage, treatment and disposal facilities authorized to accept such waste. Permittee must demonstrate that facilities are so authorized if requested to do so.
12. Maintain liability insurance as required by New York State Environmental Conservation Law.
13. Maintain records of the amount of each waste type transported to each destination facility on a calendar-year basis. The transporter is obligated to provide a report of this information to the Department at the time of permit renewal, or to any law enforcement officer, if requested to do so.
14. Pay regulatory fees on an annual basis. Non-payment may be cause for revocation or suspension of permit.
15. This permit is not transferrable. A change of ownership will invalidate this permit.
16. This permit does not relieve the permittee from the obligation to obtain any other approvals or permits, or from complying with any other applicable federal, state, or local requirement.

SAFE WORKING CONDITIONS

Safe working conditions are a primary concern at Miller Environmental Group Inc. The Company will not engage in any activity that would pose an unnecessary risk to our personnel, equipment, or the public.

Safe operating and working conditions are the responsibility of every MEG employee. Employees who witness an unsafe act or condition have the responsibility to report this to the Health & Safety Coordinator and, if able, correct the act or condition. The Coordinator will review the situation to determine what further action or assistance is required. Your branch's Safety Committee can review the entire safety program with you. In addition to details concerning Company safety policies, the committee can provide information about the Company's Health & Safety Program. All employees involved in safety-sensitive work must attend all safety meetings. If corrective action is not made in an appropriate time frame, or if a health and safety violation frequently reoccurs, or if an employee thinks a health & safety issue is not being appropriately addressed, employees have a duty and a responsibility to their coworkers to bring this to the attention of the Branch Manager.

HAZARD COMMUNICATION PROGRAM

All employees will receive, and are expected to complete, the Company's Hazard Communication Program. Such information and training is provided at the time of the Employee's initial assignment and whenever a new hazard is introduced into the employee's workplace. Therefore, all Health & Safety Personnel, Operations Personnel and Project Coordinators will receive this training within the first week of employment and before they are permitted on a job site. Environmental Coordinators, Administrative Personnel, and Field Managers will receive the training before they are permitted on a job site. The purpose of this training course is to ensure that all personnel

are trained in compliance with OSHA Regulations regarding the presence of hazardous chemicals in the workplace.

HEALTH & SAFETY TRAINING

All employees working in safety-sensitive areas must have adequate training prior to any work at such locations. Employees involved with hazardous waste operations and emergency response must complete the Company's 40-hour HAZWOPER training course in Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response or have comparable training that meets the requirements of OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 and is acceptable to MEG. Thereafter, an annual HAZWOPER refresher course is required. Those supervising employees in hazardous waste operations and emergency response will undergo additional specific training. All safety training needs are evaluated prior to the commencement of site activities. MEG's internal training department provides the necessary training each employee.

EMPLOYEES DRIVING COMPANY VEHICLES

All employees driving company vehicles regulated by the Department of Transportation (DOT) must complete DOT driver qualification requirements. These employees must comply with all DOT, state and Company regulations and policies including, but not limited to, driving records, insurance requirements, driver's daily logs.





ACCIDENTS AND INJURIES

All accidents and injuries must be reported immediately to the supervisor. Vehicle accidents must be reported on the Driver's Accident Report (MV-104) and personal injuries must be reported on the Employee Personal Injury Report (#1000). Both forms must be promptly submitted to the Human Resources Department. Supervisors must complete a Safety Compliance Counseling Form with the employee involved in the accident or injury and submit the form to the Human Resources Department. The Company maintains employee-driving records to comply with DOT regulations. An employee driving record determined to be poor or unacceptable may result in suspension or discharge.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

All employees working in safety-sensitive areas or involved in emergency spill response must have and use Company-issued safety equipment available at all job sites. The Health & Safety Coordinator is responsible for ensuring that all personnel have the proper PPE. To ensure this compliance, the Health & Safety Coordinator will conduct "spill bag" inspections. Employees responsible for their assigned spill bag are required to be present during the inspection. Inspections will be random and will not always be preannounced. Employees who are required to wear a negative pressure respirator must be clean-shaven to ensure a proper face-to-face-piece seal. Employees working in safety-sensitive areas are required to wear steel-toed safety shoes with steel shanks at all times on the job. When eye protection is required, employees working in safety-sensitive areas must wear approved safety glasses, prescription safety glasses with side shields, or safety goggles. All employees in the Hearing Conservation Program must use Company-provided hearing protection when exposed to noise levels above 90 dB (85 dB if the employee is so notified). All personal protective equipment needs are evaluated during the hazard assessment of any particular type of work to be performed.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

MEG is concerned about the physical well-being of our employees, the Company arranges for an annual physical examination for all employees working in safety-sensitive areas. This physical examination is completely paid for by the Company and will be conducted at highly regarded health care facilities. All employees working in safety-sensitive areas are also included in the Medical Surveillance Program.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL COMPLIANCE PROGRAM

In accordance with 49 CFR Parts 199 and 40 Miller Environmental Group maintains a Drug and Alcohol Program. As a component of this program MEG has implemented a random Drug and Alcohol Testing program that complies with DOT Regulations. Employee training is also a critical component of this program that informs each employee of their responsibilities as well as the employer's responsibilities.
