

- 1) What is the lift capacity of the forklift?
 - a) 6,000 pounds.
 - b) *We fill most gaylords to 2,700 – 3,000 pounds, but on rare occasions they can reach up to 3,500 pounds.*
- 2) What is the onsite storage capacity in terms of pallet/skid count?
 - a) *We store up to two gaylords and two barrels at a time. With that said, we regularly request pickups of less than the full capacity. I.e., one alkaline gaylord.*
- 3) Do you have a ramp to facilitate forklift loading?
 - a) *No. Currently, our forklift operator places the pallet or barrel on the back of the truck. Then, the vendor's driver uses a manual pallet jack to maneuver the pallet inside of the truck.*
- 4) Do you prefer drums and gaylord boxes?
 - a) *Gaylord boxes for alkaline batteries, 30-gallon or 55-gallon plastic drums with lids for button/coin style and lithium single-use batteries.*
- 5) Are the batteries stored inside or outside?
 - a) *Indoors*
- 6) What types of battery-embedded devices do you typically see in the streams (cellphones, toys, tools)?
 - a) *Vapes, toothbrushes, razors, smoke detectors, speakers, headphones, watches to name some of the more common items.*

iii) DDR batteries: \$6.95 per pound

iv) Mid-format rechargeable batteries: \$3.25 per pound

v) Battery-embedded devices: \$3.75 per pound
